Open to Registered Paint Horses Only -- Check the category or categories you are entering - \$20 per category

APHA Show Division (points accumulated from participation at APHA shows):

- Halter Horse (all ages) *Number of participants will determine if awards split by sex divisions*
- Yearling Performance (includes Longeline and In-Hand Trail)
- Solid Paint Bred (includes all halter & performance classes, including yearlings)
- Western Horse (includes western pleasure, western riding, trail)
- English Horse (includes hunter under saddle, hunter hack, working hunter, jumping)
- Driving (includes pleasure driving, utility driving)
- Reining / Gaming (includes reining, barrels, polebending, stake race, cow pony race)
- Team Penning (includes team penning)
- Working Cowhorse / Roping (includes working cowhorse, cutting, roping/heading/heeling, steer stopping)
- Amateur 45 & over (includes all amateur categories – see AM-030 on pg. 208 of rule book, & halter)
- Amateur 44 & under (includes all amateur categories – see AM-030 on pg. 208 of rule book, & halter)
- Novice Amateur (includes all amateur categories – see AM-250 on pg. 233 of rule book, points must have been accumulated in a Novice class)
- Youth 13 & under show (includes halter, western pleasure, western riding, trail, hunter under saddle, hunter hack, working hunter, jumping, hunt seat eq., hunt seat eq. over fences, showmanship, horsemanship, leadline)
- Youth 14 – 18 show (includes halter, western pleasure, western riding, trail, hunter under saddle, hunter hack, working hunter, jumping, hunt seat eq., hunt seat eq. over fences, showmanship, horsemanship)
- Youth (all ages) Reining / Gaming (includes barrels, polebending, stake race, goat tying, reining)
- Youth (all ages) Team Penning (includes team penning)
- Youth (all ages) Working Cowhorse / Roping (includes working cowhorse, cutting, roping/heading/heeling, steer stopping, breakaway roping)

APHA PAC (Paint Alternative Competition) Division (points accumulated through the APHA PAC program – see PR-000 on pg. 276 of rule book) – futurities count under this program even if not PAC:

- Halter *Number of participants will determine if awards split by sex divisions*
- Yearling longeline
- Western Horse (includes showmanship, trail/in-hand trail if APHA is awarding credit, western pleasure, western riding, western eq./horsemanship)
- English Horse (includes english showmanship, dressage, english pleasure, english eq., over fences/jumping)
- Driving
- Reining/Gaming (includes all timed events, reining)
- Team Penning
- Working Cowhorse/Roping (includes cutting, roping, working cowhorse, working ranch horse)
- Youth Halter
- Youth Western (incl. showmanship, trail, western pleasure, western riding, western eq./horsemanship, leadline)
- Youth English (incl english showmanship, dressage, english pleasure, english eq, over fences/jumping, leadline)
- Youth Reining/Gaming (includes all timed events, reining)
- Youth Team Penning
- Youth Working Cowhorse/Roping (includes cutting, roping, working cowhorse, working ranch horse)
- 4-H (includes all 4-H classes as designated in the PAC rules)

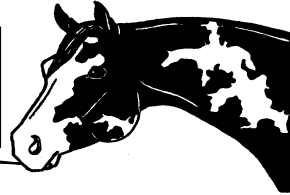

THE RULES...



- 1) MUST have sign-up sheet with payment turned in before points will count (postmark determines date of sign up). NO POINTS ARE RETROACTIVE!!!
- 2) Must be a paid and current member of INPHC prior to points accumulating.
- 3) Must help at the horse show (contact show manager for assignment). Exceptions can be made if you help at an approved club event.
- 4) Must attend at least two (2) club meetings per year (November 1st through October 31st). Exceptions with prior board approval ONLY.
- 5) Must show to at least four (4) judges to qualify. Points will accrue on the horse for the open divisions and on the rider for youth, novice, and amateur divisions.
- 6) Futurities will count on the PAC program (must have something from the futurity secretary showing placings & total number of entries in the futurity). Horse need not be enrolled in PAC.
- 7) Exhibitor will be responsible for tracking & separating equitation classes for PAC.
- 8) POINTS: will be accumulated based on the chart below (based on participation). Exhibitor must provide a print-out from APHA or a print-out from each show secretary to verify placings. Grand Champion Halter will receive 2 more points than their class placing and Reserve will receive 1 more point. **In addition to** your APHA print out, the attached point sheet can be used to supplement and make the points calculation easier on the pointskeeper.

- 10) A reserve award will be issued at the discretion of the points committee.

*Any point incurred before dues and nomination fees are paid will not count for High Point awards.
